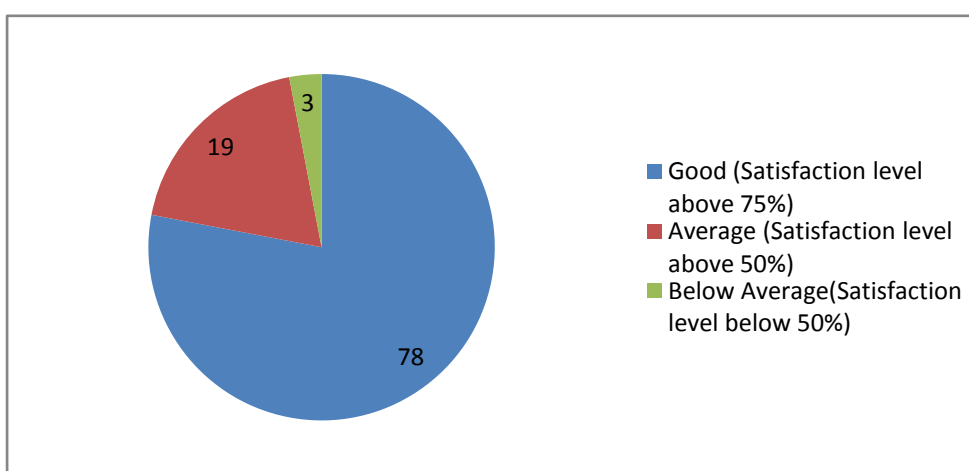


## FEEDBACK ANALYSIS & ACTION TAKEN REPORT: 2016-17

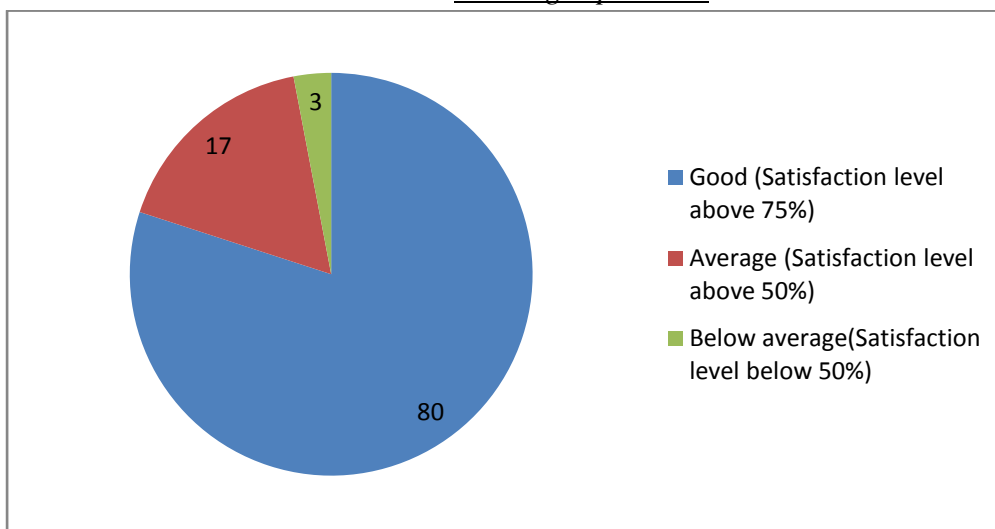
### (i) Student Feedback Analysis and Action Taken Report:

3. Statement of student satisfaction pertaining to significant aspects of campus life:

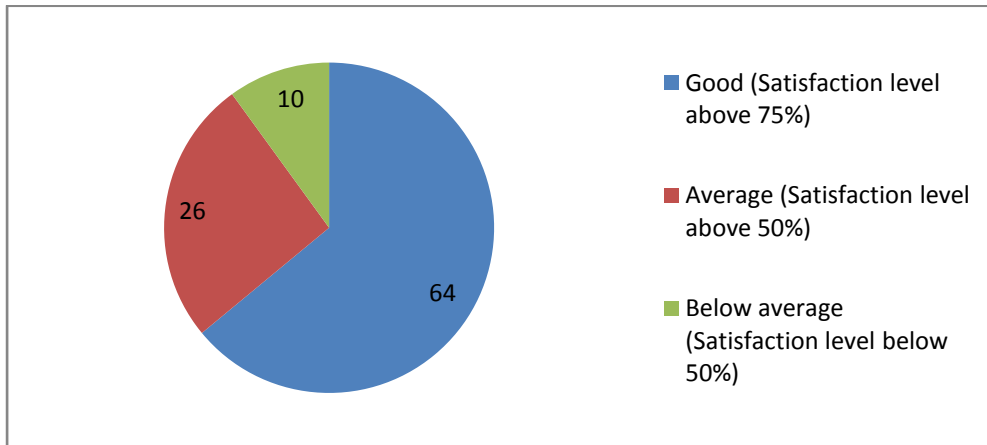
#### a. Average of the overall statement of student satisfaction pertaining to College discipline



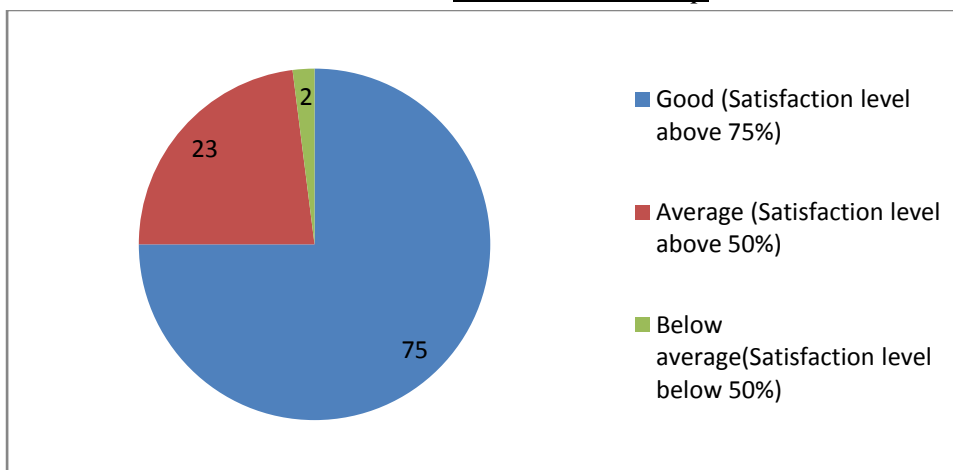
#### b. Average of the overall statement of student satisfaction pertaining to Teaching learning experience



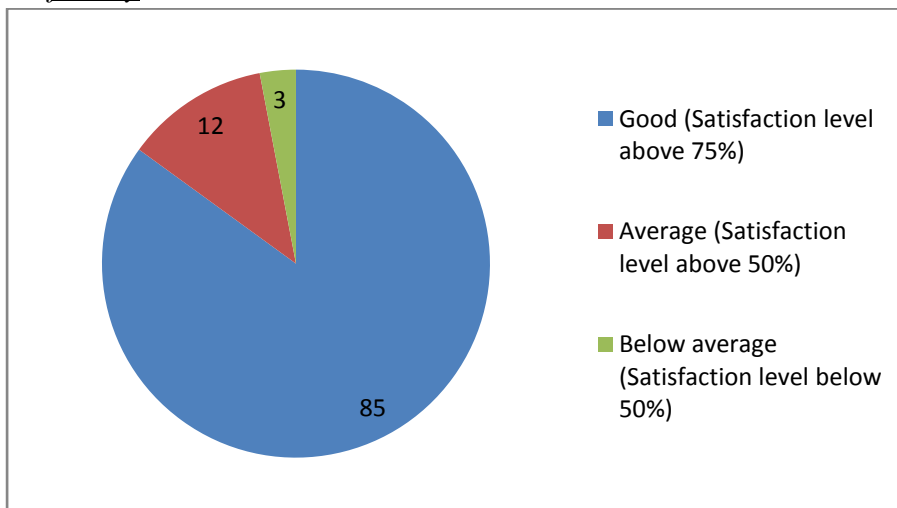
c. Average of the overall statement of student satisfaction pertaining to Co curricular activities



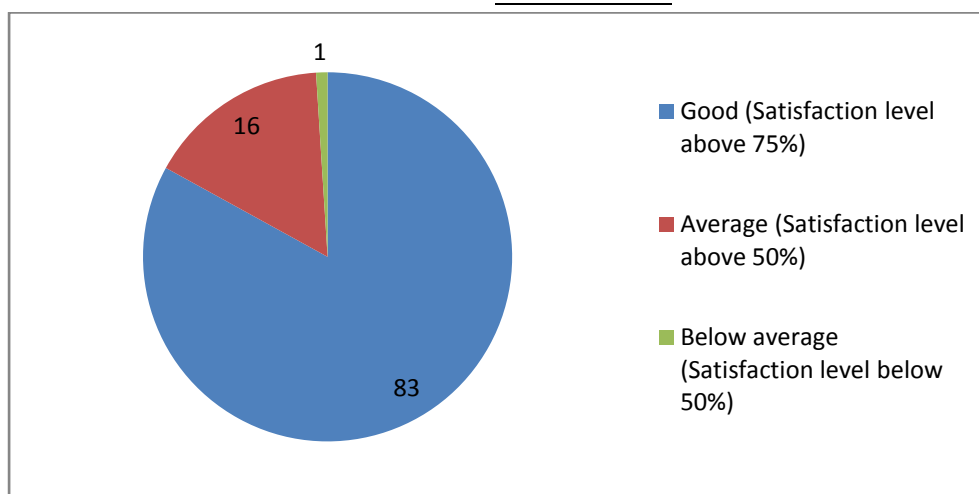
d. Average of the overall statement of student satisfaction pertaining to Teacher student relationship

**Action Taken:**

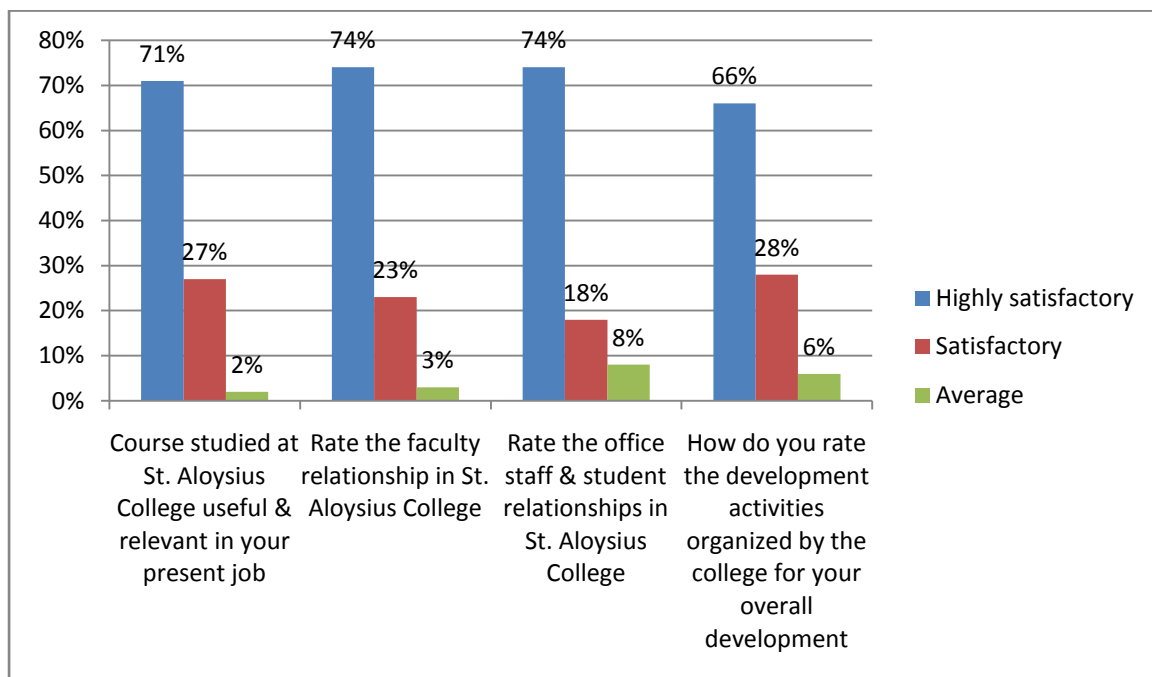
1. The council suggested that in order to implement uniform, further discussion is needed in order to know the mind of all. So decided to gather collective opinion on different platforms.
