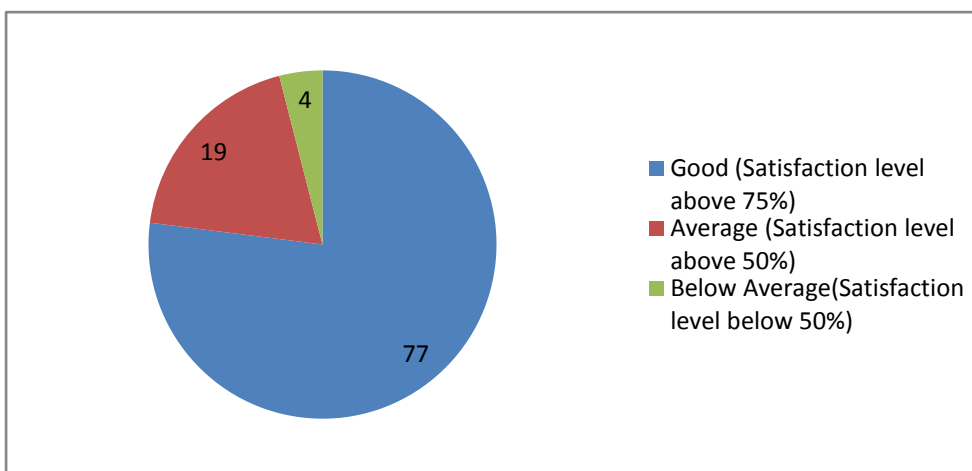

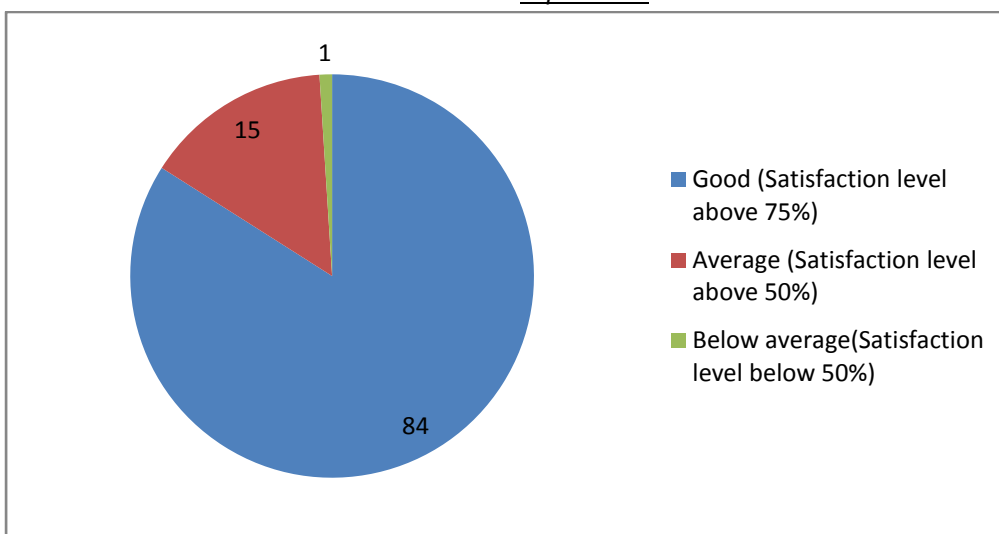
(i) Student Feedback Analysis and Action Taken Report:

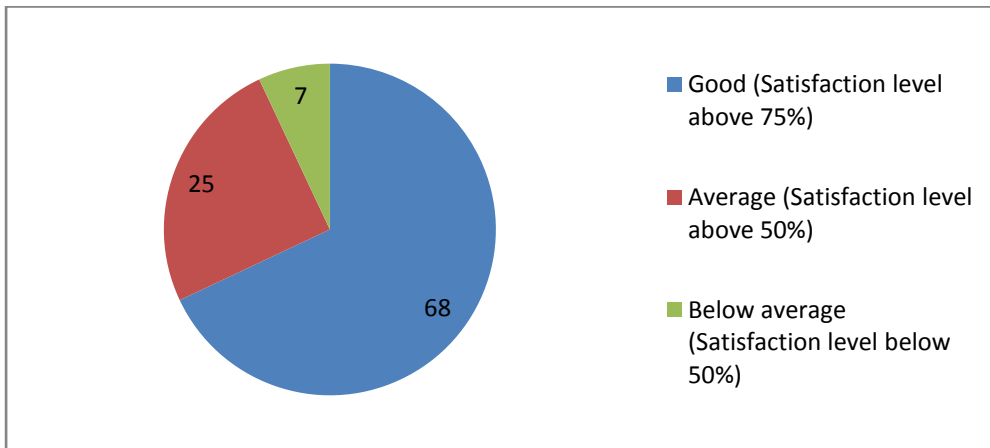
a. Average of the overall statement of student satisfaction pertaining to College discipline



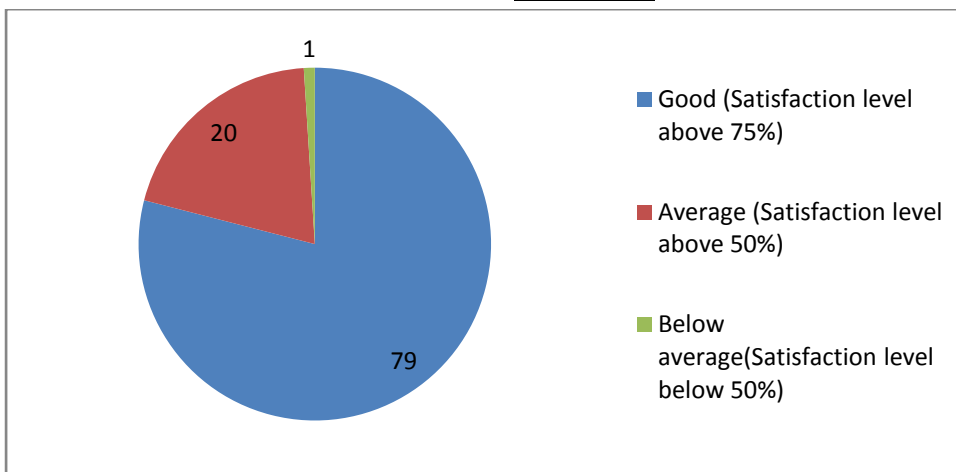
b. Average of the overall statement of student satisfaction pertaining to Teaching learning experience



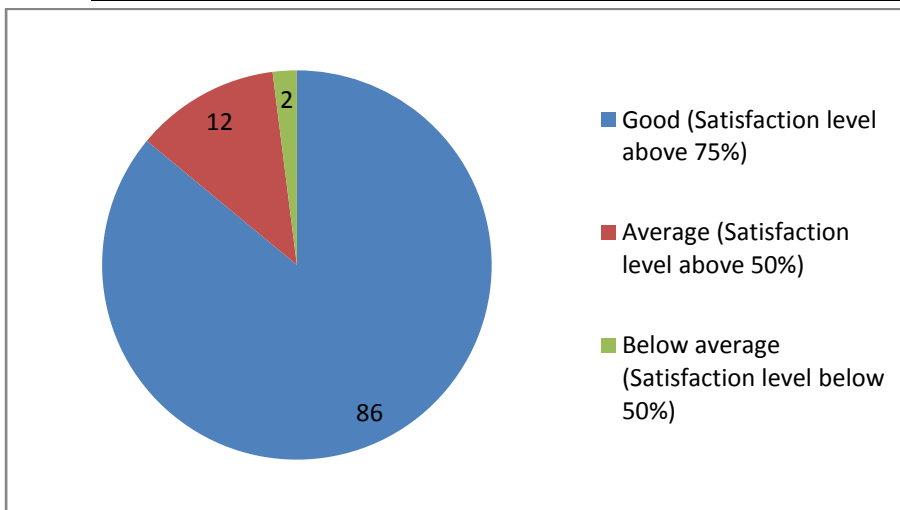
c. Average of the overall statement of student satisfaction pertaining to Co curricular activities



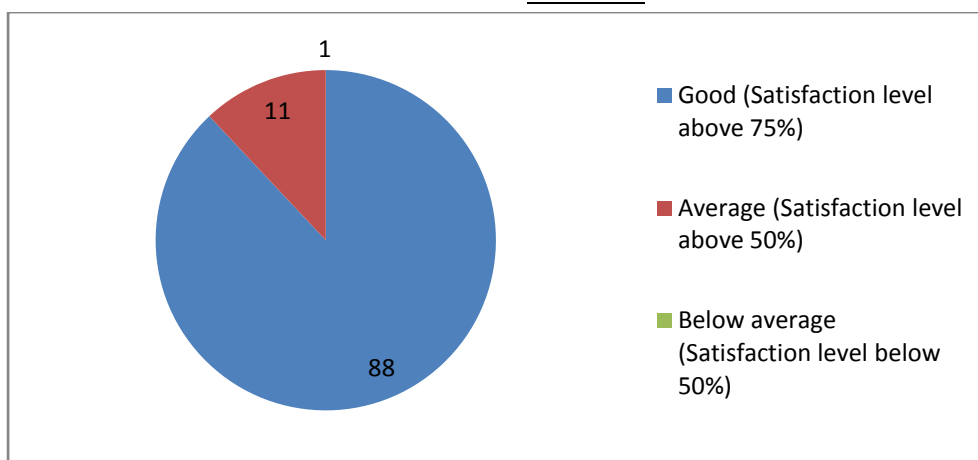
d. Average of the overall statement of student satisfaction pertaining to Teacher student relationship

Action Taken:

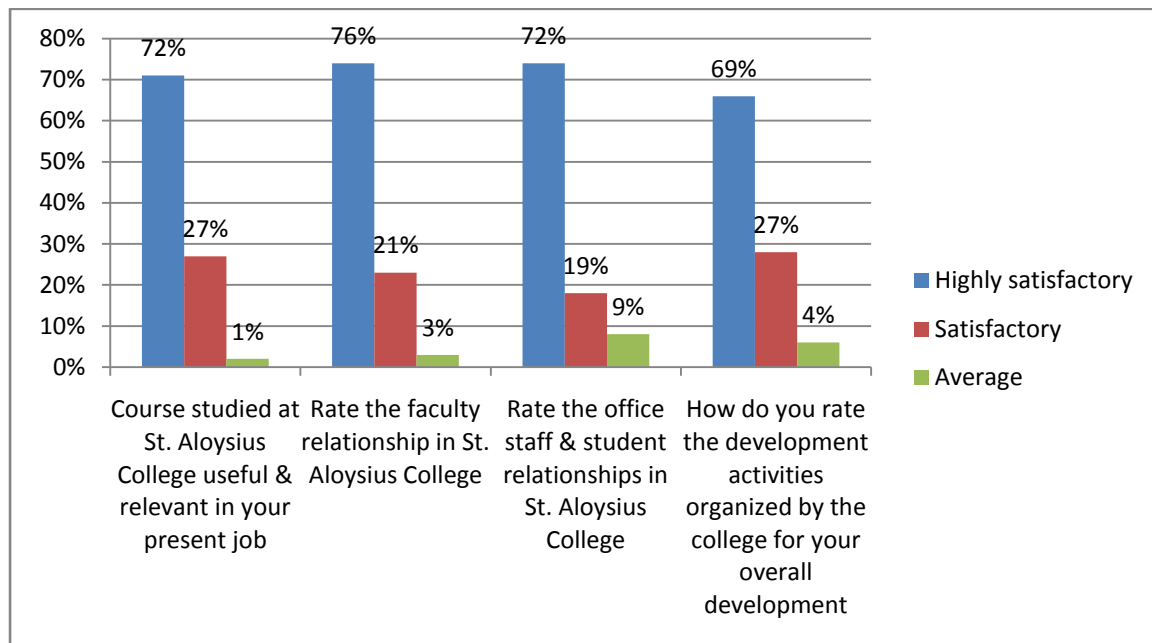
1. Discussion on implementation of college uniform was done in the PTA Executive in order to have more clarity, but couldn't arrive at a unanimous decision.

(iii) ALUMNI FEEDBACK ANALYSIS & Action Taken Report:

St Aloysius College, Elthuruth, Thrissur formally conducts alumni meet on the first Sunday of December every year. This year we conducted the meeting on 3rd December, 2017 at our college auditorium. The program was inaugurated by the manager Rev. Fr. Jose Payapilly CMI. The College Principal, Dr. Fr. Babu K T presided over the function.

Alumni meets have always been occasions to strengthen the warm relations the college maintains with its former students. This meet is also an occasion to get feedback from our Alumni. Most participants have maintained regular contact with the faculty and were updated about various events in the college. Many of the Alumni members who attended the meet had already registered in our college. This year the discussions focussed on the coming Golden Jubilee Year Celebrations of the college. All the alumni members present pledged their complete support. Based on the feedback and discussions it was also decided to make them active participants in various committees of the Golden Jubilee Celebration. They also suggested to invite prominent personalities to the celebrations. Another suggestion was to conduct a fund raising cultural programme towards charitable goals as part of the Golden Jubilee Celebrations. There was also a suggestion to organise a reunion for the 1st batch (1968) of St. Aloysius College.

Major suggestions:

1. Coaching for effective communication is required for our students.
2. Commerce curriculum may be enhanced with the inclusion of the training for organization and leadership for management event programs
3. Representatives from all batches alumni in the Golden Jubilee committees and invitations be sent to all alumni
4. Batch wise get-together should be arranged, especially the first batch of students.

Measures taken:

1. Action has been taken by the Department of English for training in English communication and personality development.
2. Training for students in organization and leadership has been done through organizing management events like Revaloysius.
3. Alumni members included in the various committees of the Golden Jubilee Celebrations. The get-together of the 1968 batch was organised.
4. Decided to organise Musical Night by Shri. Manoj George, our alumnus and Grammy Award Winner, as a fund raising charity event.

(iv). Teachers' Feedback:

The college collects information relating to the curriculum, teaching, learning and evaluation.

Significant suggestions:

1. The increased intake of the number of SDE candidates for the University examination.
2. The delayed communication from the university about the change of papers as a part of each program.

Actions taken:

1. The matter was discussed in the Heads' meeting and thus decided to send a letter to the controller of examinations requesting to restrict the number of SD candidates.
2. The BOS and Heads of departments are requested to contact the Chairman of each board to send communications at the earliest.
